Locally developed evaluation systems must be in mutual agreement with the exclusive employee representatives The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) shall review and approve the evaluation system The evaluation system shall provide, at a minimum, for an overall rating of highly effective, effective, or ineffective Teacher Evaluation

Overview of Teacher Evaluation Requirements In 2011, Public Law 90 created an evaluation system aimed at strengthening teacher and school leader performance and providing meaningful opportunities for professional growth At the time, the legislation was promoted to position Indiana as a national leader in teacher accountability Key tenets

Program Teacher Evaluation Manual

During the 2000 Legislative Session the law regarding teacher evaluation was modified Georgia law requires that all personnel employed by local units of administration have their performance evaluated annually by a trained evaluator Local school systems must align teacher evaluation instruments in compliance with the amended law
