Advance care planning is a process of planning for future healthcare decisions in case we are no longer able to make those decisions on our own Advance care planning involves early and ongoing discussions with our healthcare professionals, family members, friends, caregivers, or other designated decision-makers These discussions can help

Families in Case Planning The case plan is a living document that should reflect ongoing input from the family and be reviewed and updated throughout the life of the case Caseworkers should expect to engage the family for the initial drafting of the plan as well as throughout the planning and implementation process

a 38-item questionnaire on the availability of end-of-life and palliative care services Seventy percent of the respondents reported pain management services as the most pressing need, followed by advance care planning (58%), hospice contracts (54%), care for dying (53%), and bereavement support (52%)

Care Planning and Geriatric Assessment

comprehensive geriatric assessments and care planning is a challenge for care managers Goals of a Geriatric Assessment The care manager does a geriatric assessment to create a care plan, which proposes recommendations to repair the holes in the older client's personal safety net using the family system and the continuum of care The
